Framework for discussion and guidelines

Session 1:

The participants would be divided in working Groups and each Group will be given one of the following module for discussion

- Pension & CPFM
- GPF
- Pre-check, Master, Budget & Compilation Module
- Deviation of COMPACT from Rule position
- Ways to develop a better MIS-8 to review COMPACT implementation in a PAO
- COMPACT support strategy & feedback mechanism.

1. During course of discussion the group is required to deliberate upon following points:
 - a) Main problems associated with the module of the package/package assigned to the group. The working group would be required to enumerate 7-8 such issues during Session II.
 - b) Discuss possible improvements to make the package operationally more useful and effective.
 - c) Discuss the issues where the Computerised system deviates from existing systems as mandated by manuals/rule books.
2. Groups should preserve the working sheets used (detailing all issues of discussion) and hand them over to their respective coordinators.

Session 2:

Each group will be given 10 min for presentation of the findings of the working group with respect to (a), (b) and (c) listed above. 1 member of the group to present the main findings.

Session 3:

During the course of open session the participants are requested fully participate in discussions and give their inputs regarding various IT issues;

- a) Possible IT initiatives, which can be taken by the CGA organization for implementation in field units.
- b) Other mechanism for providing support to the implementation of packages in the field units. COMPACT support group is one such initiative.
- c) Training requirements in the Information Technology field.
- d) Any other relevant issue including e- lekha.
